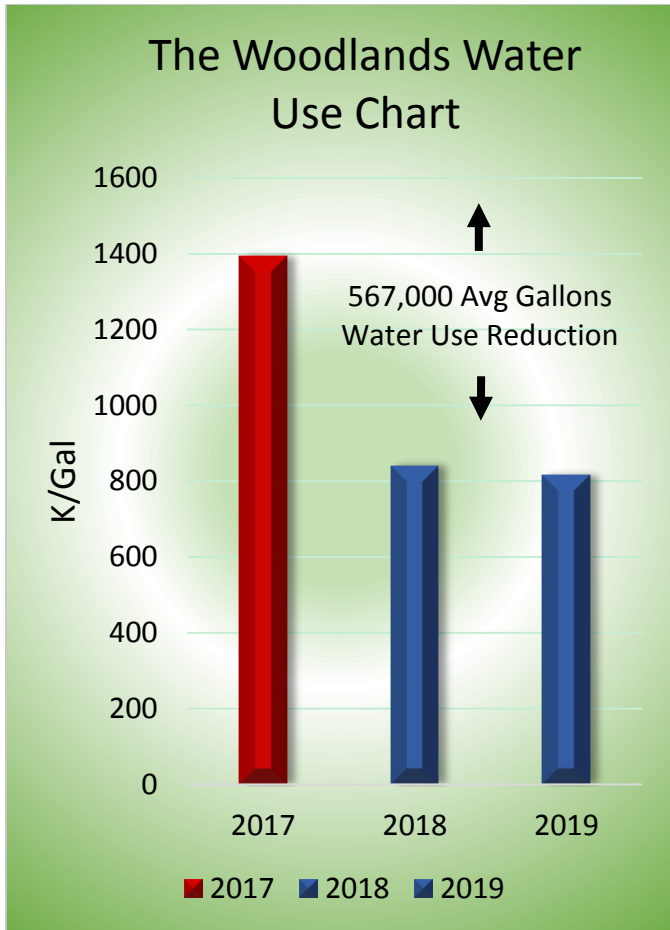
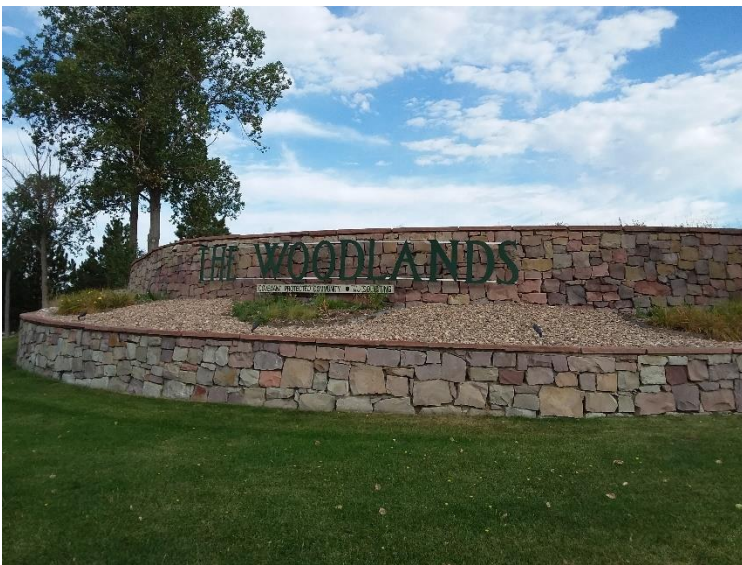


ET Irrigation continued assisting The Woodlands move towards a reduced water requirement landscape in 2019. Along with Ridge Trail Park being converted to Native Blue Grama in 2018, approximately 9000 sqft of Kentucky Blue Grass was converted in 2019. The 2019 Project cost will completely be covered by Castle Rock water conservation Rebates.



**CHALLENGE**

Continue Landscape Water Requirement Reduction in 2019 along with continuing management strategies that will deliver predictable & sustainable irrigation system efficiencies.

**PROCESS**

- Identify areas of potential water use reduction
- Work with Town of Castle Rock to convert turf open space to native grass, taking advantage of their Landscape Modification Rebate
- Implement sustainable irrigation management practices

**RESULTS: 2019**

- Sustained Water Use Reduction 500k/gal
- Approximately \$10,000 in Rebate
